SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

Thought Provoking:

Do you have a story about an "Uncle Theodore" in your family? How about great "Aunt Josephine," how her story outlived her?

Being in it together is wonderful when it all works. It's more difficult when circumstances cause it to be not so easy. What has been your experience both in groups that have worked well together and ones that have struggled? Did you receive a blessing? Were there blessings to others?

Digging Deeper:

1. Share a story that you know from the Bible about an "in together" relationship. What can we learn about their relationship with each other? What about a Bible story about someone and their relationship with God?
2. Why is Acts 13:1-5 an example of "we're in this together"?
3. Read Ephesians 4:11-13 ~ List the people who are responsible to equip God's people to do His work. What are the responsibilities of God's people? How long does this go on? What part should you play in "we're in this together"?
4. Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-31 (in the context of "we're in this together") ~ Discuss how many different people make up the group of people we call the church.

Application:

How can we impact our relationships with our family and friends when we include our relationship with God and Jesus?
